FACULTY

Brian T. Judy graduated from the University of Tulsa, College of Law in 1998 and was admitted to practice in Kentucky in 1998. He was an Assistant Attorney General and an associate with the law firm of Ferreri and Fogle. He has been an Assistant Counsel with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services since 2005. He is also a certified 13B hearing officer and certified by the Kentucky Employee Mediation Program (KEMP) as a mediator.

ROBERT G. LAWSON is a Professor at the University of Kentucky College of Law and a noted expert in evidence law. Professor Lawson served as Chair of the Evidence Rules Study Committee of the Kentucky Bar Association and is the author of *The Kentucky Rules of Evidence Law Handbook*.

Sara W. Combs has served on the Kentucky Court of Appeals since 1994 and has served as Chief Judge from 2004 through 2010. She graduated from the University of Louisville, Brandeis School of Law in 1979. She received an honorary doctor of laws degree from Union College in 2007. Her varied and distinguished law career includes work on the 1985 landmark school reform that ultimately led to the passage of the Kentucky Education Reform Act (KERA). In 1993 she became the first woman to serve on the Kentucky Supreme Court.

Stuart W. Cobb, Susan S. Durant and Michael Head serve as a full-time hearing officers in the Administrative Hearings Branch, Office of the Attorney General.
