FIRST TERM ACCOMPLISHMENTS



Despite unprecedented budget cuts, Attorney General Jack Conway and his staff have accomplished a great deal for Kentucky families over the past four years. The following are highlights of General Conway's many achievements since becoming Kentucky's 49th Attorney General in January of 2008.

Cybercrimes & Cybersafety

- ▶ Created Cybercrimes Unit to combat crimes that occur online.
- ▶ Launched more than 250 child porn investigations and seized more than 300,000 child pornographic images and videos from the Internet.
- ▶ Examined more than 5,600 hard drives and removable devices.



Combating Prescription Drug Abuse

- ▶ Created Kentucky's first statewide prescription drug abuse task force to focus on investigations into doctor shopping, drug trafficking, overprescribing physicians and illegal out-of-state pharmacies.
- ▶ Participated in Operation Flamingo Road, Kentucky's largest prescription drug bust.
- ▶ Worked in a bipartisan fashion with Florida Attorney General Pam Bondi to shut down illegal pill pipeline running from Florida to Kentucky.
- ▶ Partnering with other AGs to ensure electronic prescription drug monitoring is implemented in all states.
- ▶ Alerted thousands of middle and high school students to the dangers of prescription drug abuse by launching statewide Keep Kentucky Kids Safe program.



Combating Medicaid Fraud & Elder Abuse

- ▶ Increased Medicaid fraud collections by 600 percent with recoveries/awards totaling more than \$215.6 million.
- ▶ \$76 million of those Medicaid funds came back to Kentucky. 97% returned to CHFS. 3% to OAG
- ▶ Launched more than 100 abuse and neglect investigations; more than any previous attorney general.

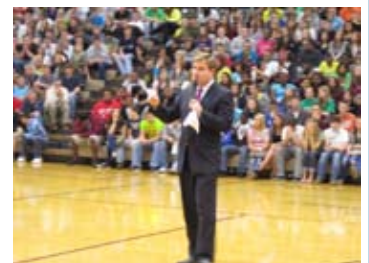


Rate Intervention

- ▶ Intervened in rate cases before the Public Service Commission (PSC), resulting in savings of nearly \$825 million for Kentucky rate payers.

Making our Communities Safer

- ▶ Utilizing an ARRA grant, funded implementation of eWarrants in 99 of Kentucky's rural counties, bringing the total number of counties utilizing eWarrants to 115, nearly the entire state.



- ▶ Launched KY Kids Alert program to alert Kentucky parents and child care providers about important child product recalls. Approximately 3,000 Kentucky child care centers and family child care homes now receive safety recall alert information.

Protecting Kentucky Consumers

- ▶ Launched investigation into the questionable business practices of some of Kentucky's for-profit colleges.
- ▶ Leading national coalition of 24 Attorneys General investigating illegal activity at some for-profit colleges.
- ▶ Reached agreement with Student Loan Xpress for \$3.6 million in loan reductions for students of now defunct American Justice School of Law in Paducah.
- ▶ Reached settlements totaling \$107,500 with eight retail stations as part of a gas price-gouging investigation in wake of Hurricane Ike and Kentucky's windstorm.
- ▶ Led nationwide effort to stop abuses on Topix.com
- ▶ \$60 million in civil judgments pending. These cases are on appeal or not final. \$11 million collected. Majority goes to General Fund.
