III. Old Business

A. FDA Action

On December 7, 2022, the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Texas ruled in favor of R.J. Reynolds that FDA's regulation requiring graphic cigarette warning labels is unconstitutional. FDA has appealed to the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals.

B. Kentucky/Synar

One PM, TABESA, stopped making quarterly payments and the states are pursuing enforcement actions against it. The company was removed from the Kentucky Tobacco Directory in May.

Kentucky MSA payment received in two wire transfers April 17-20. The total payment was \$118 million.

Synar inspections increased by 100 for 2023.
