MINUTES OF THE TOBACCO MASTER SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT COMPLIANCE ADVISORY BOARD MEETING

September 29, 2021

The seventy-seventh meeting of the Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement Compliance Advisory Board was convened by conference call on September 29, 2021, at the Office of the Attorney General, 700 Capitol Avenue, Frankfort, Kentucky.

- **II. Minutes** adopted from previous meeting.

III. Old Business

A. E-Cigarettes/JUUL

- VUSE has opened its first VUSE INSPIRATION STORE in Houston. It
 appears to resemble the approach taken in IQOS stores, with "friendly VUSE
 ambassadors," and other similar tactics. Vuse is 2d in market share for e-cigs.
- Settlement negotiations with JUUL continuing.

B. NPM Adjustment Settlement

• 2020 proceeding began with document production to the data clearing house on August 1, 2021. Preliminary report found Kentucky should have no reduction to its payment.

C. FDA Action

- Challenge to final rules on graphic warnings still pending decisions in federal courts. Warnings delayed to October, 2022.
- On September 9, 2021, FDA announced that it had completed review of more than 90% of the PMTAs submitted by the September 9, 2020 deadline. No marketing orders were issued; marketing denial orders were issued for almost a

- million flavored ENDS products because FDA concluded "that they failed to provide sufficient evidence that those products will benefit adult smokers to an extent sufficient to justify their documented risks to youth." No action yet taken on the market-leading ENDS products, including JUUL, VUSE and NJOY.
