MINUTES OF THE TOBACCO MASTER SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT COMPLIANCE ADVISORY BOARD MEETING

March 16, 2022

The seventy-ninth meeting of the Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement Compliance Advisory Board was convened on March 16, 2022, by conference call.

III. Old Business

A. E-Cigarettes/JUUL

- JUUL negotiations continue on numerous lawsuits and investigations.
- An FTC administrative law judge has issued a decision dismissing FTC staff's antitrust challenge to Altria's purchase of a 35% interest in JUUL. The decision is subject to review by the Commission and then in court. Commission staff has filed a notice of appeal to the Commission.

B. FDA Action

- Graphic warning challenges continue in TX, DC. Effective date extended to April 9, 2023 in TX case more than one year after briefing has concluded.
- Legislation was approved in Congress to include synthetic nicotine within the definition of "tobacco product." FDA given the authority to conduct premarket review of synthetic nicotine products within 120 days.
- ABC will seize illegal products that they see when clear violations.
