

Kentucky Opioid Abatement Advisory Commission Treatment and Recovery Subcommittee January 28, 2025

MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Ingram called the Treatment and Recovery Subcommittee application review meeting to order at 1:04 p.m. on Tuesday, January 28, 2025.

II. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Patricia Freeman moved to adopt the January 28, 2025, agenda. Jason Roop seconded, and the motion carried.

III. NEW BUSINESS

1. February 18th application review meeting date change

Patricia Freeman moved to reschedule the February 18th application review meeting to February 20th, 2025, to begin at 1:00 p.m. Jason Roop seconded, and the motion carried.

2. January 31st application review meeting
