

Kentucky Opioid Abatement Advisory Commission Prevention, Reform, Compliance Subcommittee April 24, 2024

MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Purdy called the Prevention, Reform, Compliance Subcommittee application review meeting to order at 10:13 a.m. on Wednesday, April 24, 2024.

II. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Allen Brenzel moved to adopt the April 24, 2024, agenda. Treasurer Metcalf seconded, and the motion carried.

III. NEW BUSINESS

1. Approve additional application review meetings.

Darren Allen moved to adopt May 14, 2024, beginning at 10:00 a.m. as the next Prevention application review meeting. Treasurer Metcalf seconded, and the motion carried.

IV. EXECUTIVE SESSION

Chair Purdy stated a motion was made, seconded, and adopted for the Subcommittee to retire into closed, executive session. This motion has passed by a majority vote of the members present, with enough members present to form a quorum.

Specific justification under the Kentucky Open Meetings Act for this action are as follows: meetings of any selection committee, evaluation committee, or other similar group established under KRS Chapter 45A or 56 or other state or local law, to select a successful bidder for award of a state or local contract.

This meeting will consider matters mandated by KRS 15.291(5), which comports with the exception found in KRS 61.810(1)(n).
