

Kentucky Opioid Abatement Advisory Commission Treatment and Recovery Subcommittee April 26, 2024

MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Ingram called the Treatment and Recovery Subcommittee application review meeting to order at 10:02 a.m. on Friday, April 26, 2024.

II. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Karen Butcher moved to adopt the April 26, 2024, agenda. Jason Roop seconded, and the motion carried.

III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

10:04 a.m. – Karen Butcher moved the Subcommittee go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing bidders for award moneys from the opioid abatement trust fund established in KRS 15.293, pursuant to KRS 15.291(5), but only include matters that are allowed to be discussed during executive session pursuant to KRS 61.810. Jason Roop seconded, and the motion carried.

Chair Ingram stated a motion was made, seconded, and adopted for the Subcommittee to retire into closed, executive session. This motion has passed by a majority vote of the members present, with enough members present to form a quorum.

Pursuant to KRS 61.810(1)(n), of the Kentucky Open Meetings Act, the Committee will now retire into closed, executive session. Specific justification under the Kentucky Open Meetings Act for this action are as follows: meetings of any selection committee, evaluation committee, or other similar group established under KRS Chapter 45A or 56 or other state or local law, to select a successful bidder for award of a state or local contract.

This meeting will consider matters mandated by KRS 15.291(5), which comports with the exception found in KRS 61.810(1)(n).
