VII. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR UPDATES

1. Update Regarding Regulations to County and City Reporting

Mrs. Chavies thanked the Commission members for not only their kind words but also for their time and dedication to the Commission. Mrs. Chavies also expressed her support for the Commission to consider setting up a scholarship fund for individuals impacted by substance use disorder.
