
Pursuant to Section 78 of the Kentucky Constitution, please provide me, in writing, with a list of any and all matters referred to the Office of the Attorney General's Division of Administrative Hearings (the "Division") between January 1, 2010, and the present date by any state organizational unit identified in KRS 12.020. For each such matter listed, please include the following:

- (1) The date(s) on which the matter was referred to the Division;
- (2) The name(s) of the attorney(s) in the Division assigned to adjudicate each matter referred;
- (3) The date(s), if any, on which the matter referred was submitted to the attorney in the Division serving as a hearing officer for decision or opinion;
- (4) The date(s), if any, on which the attorney in the Division, serving as a hearing officer, filed his or her decision or opinion in the matter referred; and
- (5) The total amount of money, if any, subdivided into its appropriate billable amounts, that the Division billed to the state organizational unit for each matter referred.

Pursuant to Section 78 of the Kentucky Constitution, please also provide me your assessment as to whether the Division is operating—and has operated—efficiently, as well as whether the Division has complied with all of the requirements of KRS Chapter 13B in adjudicating matters.
