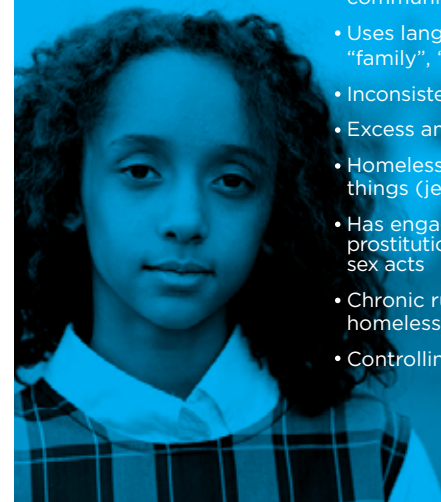

- Branding (*neck, wrist, chest*)
- Tattoos (*name of pimp, nickname or symbol*)
- Holding multiple id's/fake id's
- Access to one or more hotel keys/cards
- Frequently moves, changes locations-either through state, community or out of state
- Not knowing what city, state, community they are in
- Uses language like "daddy", "family", "the life"
- Inconsistencies with their story
- Excess amounts of cash
- Homeless but has nice things (jewelry,clothes)
- Has engaged in stripping, prostitution or commercial sex acts
- Chronic runaway/homeless youth
- Controlling 3rd party

*5 screening questions:*

Is anyone forcing you to do anything you do not want to do?

Have you been forced into stripping, having sex or other sex acts?

Have you exchanged something sexual for something you needed to survive, such as food, shelter or money?

Are you being made to do something (work or something sexual) to pay off a debt or meet a quota?

Do you feel like you are being controlled by someone?
